Victory Fellowship Ministry Leads Meeting

Affiliation: Victory is currently non-denominational and has been for approximately 8 years. Young Adult Ministry: Pastor Dan reported that the ministry numbers have grown recently, but there is an inconsistency in who attends. He would like to form a leadership committee from within to encourage attendance and plan out future events.

Ministry Event Coordinator or Committee: An event coordinator or committee would be useful for all the events that are being planned outside of Sunday service (Relay for Life, Harvest Festival, Church Retreat, etc). After discussion, it was decided that Jon and Mike would put a job description and the events that would fall under this ministry. To be brought up at the next board meeting.

Pastor Earl and Youth Worship: Pastor Earl will be working with the youth on a regular basis (quarterly) to teach Biblical basis for worship and also technical aspects of worship. He will try to develop the musical skills of the youth for a future worship team.

Retreat Update: Gary presented to the board the need to increase the conference reservation to 120 people. A youth speaker has been chosen and they are still looking for an adult speaker. The children's ministry plans are almost solidified.

Relay For Life: Victory had a good level of participation with all the time slots filled with at least one person. The restaurant fund raiser was successful raising over \$400.00.

Ministry Videos: We had good feedback on the ministry videos, but not much response. We may have an opportunity to reuse the videos at a later date.
